Pre-Operative General Anesthesia Instructions:

DIET

1. DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ON THE DAY OF SURGERY.

ESCORT

1. A Responsible adult must accompany the patient and remain at the surgical center during the surgery time.
2. Children under the age 18 must have a parent or guardian legally authorized to sign consent.
3. Patients must not drive for 24 hours after general anesthesia.

CLOTHING

1. Wear comfortable clothing with short sleeved blouse or shirt.
2. Wear low heeled shoes.

OTHER

1. Diabetics, small children, pregnant or nursing mothers, and patients with any significant medical conditions should contact us prior to surgery for special instructions.
2. If you develop any cold or flu symptoms prior to surgery, please contact our office.
3. If you were prescribed an antibiotic, please start taking it the day before surgery.
4. Marijuana use slows digestion and increases the risk of aspiration. Refrain from the use of Marijuana for at least twenty-four hours before surgery.
